## Additional Instructions for Suspension Appeal

- 1. If you have already enrolled in courses for an upcoming semester, your courses will be held until your suspension appeal has been decided.
- 2. As soon as a decision is reached, administration will notify you of the outcome of your appeal by email to your Northwest Tech student email account. It is critical during the suspension appeal period, that you monitor your email regularly in case additional information or meetings are requested.
- 3. If your appeal is denied, your courses for the upcoming semester will be dropped.
- 4. Students who are not enrolled in a minimum of 12 hours are not permitted to remain in campus housing, and must vacate the college dorms within 24 hours.
- 5. Submit your appeal in person or by mail as follows:
