c.	Automotive Technology & Diesel Technology programs require specialty tools that you should purchase on your own as they are not available for sale through the NT Bookstore.				
d.	Housing cost includes a \$200 non-refundable down payment. This is required with a signed contract in order to reserve a spot.				
e.	Both the Civil & Mechanical Engineering programs require a purchase of a specific laptop through Northwest Tech. This laptop is used during the 2nd, 3rd and 4th semesters of the program. The Laptop is not required to start the program.				
f.	Cosmetology, Medical Assistant, Welding, Powersports Technology - To obtain an Associate Degree in these 1 year programs, additional tuition and fees may apply.				
g.	Kansas Law (K.S.A 65-1912): all cosmetology students MUST obtain an apprentice license. Non-refundable \$15 application fee, photocopy of your current US government issued photo ID, photocopy of your social security card. The name on the application and the identification documents must match exactly. Any applicant that has been convicted of a felony, must complete the felony packet. Please see the instructor for details. If a student is unable to obtain a license within the first 15 days, the student must withdraw or will be administratively withdrawn from the program.				
h.	Background Check \$52 - A background check is required for these programs. A felony conviction would prohibit enrollment in these programs due to clinical and licensing requirements. Medical Assistant and Respiratory Care students need to have reliable transportation and financial means (if a student is financial aid eligible these funds may assist with these costs) to attend required clinical rotations.				
i.	The Cloud & Crypto Computing program requires students to purchase a laptop before the start of the first year with required specs. Inquire for the list. Laptop (approx. \$1800)
